**Resolved**: School Bus Stop (item 89. 13.12.22) was re-located on 5.1.23 (by Councillor agreement at The December Meeting), from The Hollow and arranged with Head of Transport, Dauntsey's, in response to the concerns raised by local residents about the safety of the children at pick up and set down, in term time, especially during the winter months; to Small Street. Further comments were reported by locals in Small Street, on 9.1.23 via Pewsey Vale coaches, to The School and subsequently relayed to the Clerk. PC

Councillors discussed the importance of the safety of the children, 4 pupils using the bus at Chirton, aged 11-13 and it was decided to keep the bus stop on Small Street, due to less passing traffic, but locate at the 'Salisbury Red' bus stopping point, near Thumbwood Terrace.

- Planning Application PL/2022/09614 22 Small Street, Chirton Devizes SN10 3QR. Proposed erection of detached double garage with Gym over. Councillors reviewed and discussed this application. They raised a couple of questions regarding the Planning consent and had questions for the Case Officer in order that they may comment:
  - 1. The external staircase, it was thought, must be space saving, hence it is on the outside; is this aesthetic or to do with fire regulations?
  - 2. Is the existing garage integral to the house and will it incorporate another room, does this require planning?

It was thought that the landing of the external staircase may overlook neighbouring property. Also the application is made in a AONB and on the edge of the conservation area. Action: Clerk to email case officer and request further information and a consultation extension.
