- 139 Chair opens the meeting and welcomes Councillors and attendees.
- 140 Apologies for absence - None
- 141 Receive declarations of interest or requests for dispensation - PRH declared that due to her partners employment with Manor Farm, she would not comment on associated items.
- 142 Receive and approve Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 10th February 2026. The prepared Minutes of Parish Council Meeting had been circulated, confirmed as a true representation of the meeting held and signed by the Chair.
- 143 Representations from Members of the Public, for any items not listed.
- A question was raised concerning speeding in the village and what can be done? PRH had attended a meeting at the school and the ongoing issue of speeding, volume of cars at peak times and parking and the discussions, including the use of the school grounds for staff parking and an application for an auto-speed sign. Also direction for the electorate toward reporting regularly speeding vehicles that have been identified, direct to the police. Cllr. CA suggested we bulk-buy 20mph stickers for village use.
 - 3 bin bags were spotted on the CHIR17 Footpath and need to be cleared, Councillors agreed to do this.
 - Hedges are requested to be cut back at Chirton Lodge and 1 & 3 Patney Road as they are and causing traffic to move into the middle of the road to avoid overgrowth.

 - Dod waste bins - Tactical breach of contract - fortnightly service at a cost of £35.10 per Month, 3 misses, nine bin emptying dates have been missed, before Christmas and in the next year.
